Procès-Verbal of Correction

With Circular Note of 6 December 2016, the Federal Foreign Office, by virtue of the German Government's function as depositary of the Agreement of 13 September 1983 for Cooperation in Dealing with Pollution of the North Sea by Oil and Other Harmful Substances (Bonn Agreement), duly circulated the text for the formal correction of the

Decision of the Contracting Parties to the Bonn Agreement of 21 September 2001 to enable the accession of Ireland to the Agreement.

Pursuant to the procedure envisaged in Article 79 (2) of the Vienna Convention on the Law of Treaties for the correction of treaties, the Federal Foreign Office had proposed a period of three months from the date of the above mentioned communication, i.e. until 6 March 2017, within which any Contracting Party could have raised objections to the proposed corrections.

As no objections have been received within this period, the proposed corrections are now deemed adopted. The corrected text shall replace the defective text ab initio.
