

**Agreement**  
**regarding the Status of Personnel of Sending States**  
**attached to an International Military Headquarters of NATO**  
**in the Federal Republic of Germany**

Bonn, 7 February 1969

**Entry into force:** 21 December 1969, in accordance with Article 4 (2) thereof:

"The present Agreement shall enter into force thirty days after the date on which the Federal Republic of Germany and at least one other signatory State have deposited their instruments of ratification or approval, but not before the Protocol has entered into force for the Federal Republic of Germany. It shall enter into force for each other signatory State thirty days after the date on which it has deposited its instrument of ratification or approval."  
*((Note: according to Article 1 c) 'Protocol' means the Protocol on the Status of International Military Headquarters set up pursuant the North Atlantic Treaty, signed at Paris on 28 August 1952))*
